Join us for a Memorial in honor of fallen Maine Heroes on Saturday, Feb. 27th

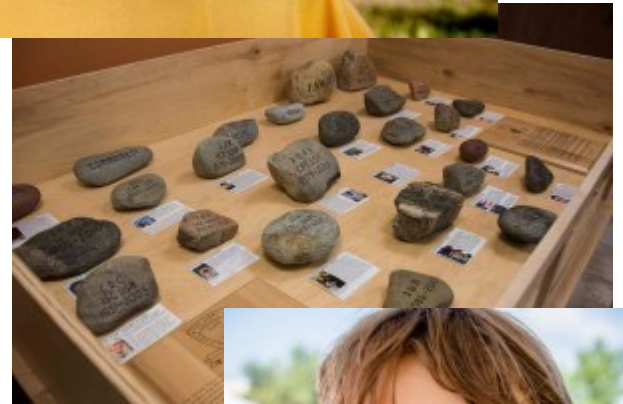
